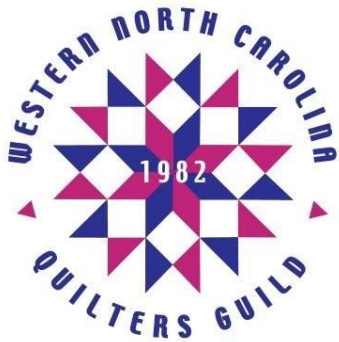

## Western North Carolina Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes - October 17, 2019

In Bridget O'Malley's absence, Vice President Linda Gillette brought the meeting to order and welcomed guests/new members to the Guild meeting. She read the slate of officer and committee nominations, (also listed in the Grainlines), and stated the guild would vote on the slate at the November meeting.

Joanne Shafer reminded members to get their raffle tickets from their Area Reps for the *Cross and Double Cross* quilt donated by Georgia Bonesteel to benefit the Scholarship fund.

Bonnie Cunningham spoke about Quilts of Valor and invited members to a ceremony at the Kaplan Auditorium, Hendersonville Main Library, on Saturday, October 26 at 10:30 am.

Bonnie Hartel stated National Quilt Day is being celebrated March 21, 2020. The challenge is to make a place mat size quilt with any color fabric but the theme is "This is My Home". Quilts will be collected at the February meeting.

Abbie Vesely, from the Area 5 luncheon hosts, said the Christmas party would be in the Fellowship Hall of this church on December 12 at 11 am. Dandelion is catering, reservations can be sent to Bonnie Hartel with checks payable to "Area 5".

Treasurer Sheryl Jamerson stated the 2020 budget will be printed in the Grainlines and voted on at the November meeting. The biggest change in the budget is the increase in the cost of membership, proposed by the Board, to support quality programs.

Linda Lou Harris reviewed upcoming programs and introduced today's speaker, our own Terry Shuler. After Show & Tell the meeting adjourned at 10:30. Terry, showing many examples, talked about the quilting decision process and offered her insight and suggestions on the quilt tops brought in by members.

## Scholarship Fund Raffle Quilt 2019-2020

Georgia Bonesteel has donated her quilt, *Check and Double Check*, for a raffle quilt with donations benefitting the Scholarship Fund. This special quilt uses a combination of reversible tartan plaids, offset with bands of calico and hand quilted stars to create a quilt with Americana appeal. The design was inspired by a scrap of wrapping paper and a glass panel Georgia had seen in a restaurant. The quilt measures 82 inches by 94 inches.

The raffle tickets are \$1.00 each or 6 for \$5.00. The drawing for the quilt will be held on March 21, 2020, (National Quilt Day). The winning ticket holder does not have to be present to win.
