Mary Stori is an internationally recognized quiltmaker, fashion designer, instructor, lecturer and quilt show judge. She has authored a cookbook, six quilt books and a DVD, "Mary Stori Teaches You Beading on Fabric." Her newest book is "Embellishing with Felted Wool." Mary was named 2004 Teacher of the Year by Professional Quilter.

She has written extensively and had work appear in scores of quilt magazines and publications. Her award winning work has been widely exhibited both nationally and internationally. She has appeared on HGTV's "Simply Quilts" and "Sew Perfect" several times. An entire episode of Fon's & Porter's "Love of Quilting" featured her beaded quilts. She designed the Mary Stori Collection for Kona Bay Fabrics, and her own line of stencils for Quilting Creations.

Her work is often humorous, generously embellished and displays fine hand quilting. She loves the challenge of creating one-of-a-kind quilts and fashions and traveling worldwide to present lectures and workshops that help to keep her motivated.

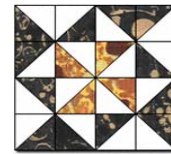

Block of the Season

Celebrating Rosie the Riveter: "Peace and Plenty"

and scroll down in the M-R list to the "Peace and Plenty" block.

Block = 12½" unfinished, do not square up
Two Fabrics and Rotary Cutting =

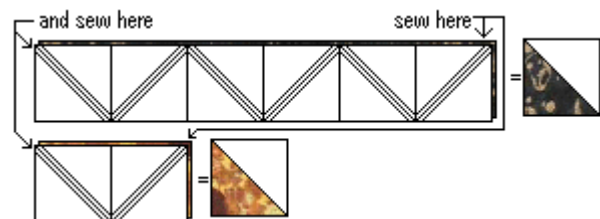
Color #1 = Dark: one, 3 7/8" x 23 1/4"

Color #2 = Accent: one, 3 7/8" x 7 3/4"

Color #3 = Light bkgd.: one, 3 7/8" x 23 1/4" + one, 3 7/8" x 7 3/4"

All the units for this block will be speed pieced. First, stack the Color 1 and Color 3, 3 7/8" x 23, 1/4" strips, right sides together, marking the 3 7/8" square lines, marking the diagonals in the directions shown, and then sewing a scant 1/4" above and below the marked diagonals, pivoting at the 3 7/8" square lines. Cut apart ON the marked diagonals, and cut apart on the square lines as well. This will give you twelve half squares. Press seams to darker side, and trim these back to measure 3-1/2" if needed. Repeat this same method with the Color 2 and Color 3, 3-7/8" x 7-3/4" strips to make four more half squares in that color arrangement.

Sew together horizontal rows using the standard scant 1/4" seam allowance and pressing seams in alternating directions by row. Sew the rows together, and you are done!
