Kevin Womack - Guild Meeting Speaker

Kevin Womack is a textile artist living in Lynchburg, Virginia. While majoring in the sciences at James Madison University, he satisfied his strong interest in the arts by including several elective art courses as part of his studies. Kevin earned his bachelor's degree in Computer Science and went to work in the IT field. He continued his artist pursuits, exploring photography, metals/jewelry, pottery and oil painting in community art classes.

In 1986, Kevin was introduced to quilting by his maternal grandmother. Having always loved the legacy of family quilts, he decided to have her teach him the tradition. While his interest in other media has waned, his passion for fiber has endured. Kevin is passionate about hand dyeing and patterning fabrics with surface design techniques. His experiments produce a line of unique fabrics and clothing that he exhibits and sells.

Kevin's artwork and quilts have been exhibited at several local and regional shows. His collaborative work with artist Eleanor McCain was selected for inclusion in the Quilt National '13 exhibition and Quilt Visions Biennial 2014. In addition to his fabric business, Kevin teaches and lectures nationally. He recently taped an episode for *The Quilt Show* with Alex Anderson and Ricky Tims (Show #2613) to air in June of 2020. <https://thequiltshow.com/watch/show-list/video/latest/show-2613-kevin-womack-create-fabric-cheryl-phillips-a-braided-twist>

On Thursday, March 19 at the Guild meeting, Kevin will give a lecture and trunk show of more than 70 quilts. The 6 hour workshop is on Friday, March 20th from 9:30 - 4:30 and is a Color Study. Using scraps of various tone-on-tone fabrics the students bring in and share, we will assemble 9 star blocks according to different color theories. This will most likely be a no sewing class, so students can focus on learning the theories and concentrate on working with color. Students will pin their fabric combinations to flannel and then assemble blocks at home.

We reviewed our new Yearbook and pointed out in particular that the hostesses of the Christmas Luncheon are listed for the next 4 years and the list of Areas and when they bring "goodies" for the longer break this year are also listed. Both are on page 5 of your new directory.

This year in the Quilt Show Committees we are forming a Funding committee to ask for Banks and other groups to consider underwriting some of our costs of the show. In that process we are developing a flyer to present to the Groups we will be asking. We need some pictures of our donation items and the process of gathering them and sewing them and other events where we are involved in the community. So if you are having a sewing event, a QOV event etc., please take some pictures and give a copy of them to Bridget O'Malley or Cathie Shelton so we can use them in our flyer.

We clarified who our Sunshine person sends cards to. They go to members at time of illness. Bereavement cards are sent to members and their spouses in case of death and to members when a daughter or son dies. The Guild does not send cards for other occasions in their family life.

We talked about getting the Scholarship recipients in the paper with pictures and text about the program. The committee is revamping the scholarship process and will inform us about it soon.

We talked about a separate treasurer for the Quilt Show and our current Treasurer, Sheryl Jamerson expressed that she thought it was not necessary because she is training the person who will be taking over next year, and is training her about the Quilt Show. So we accepted that and didn't discuss it any more. We'll review it again after the Quilt Show for the future.
